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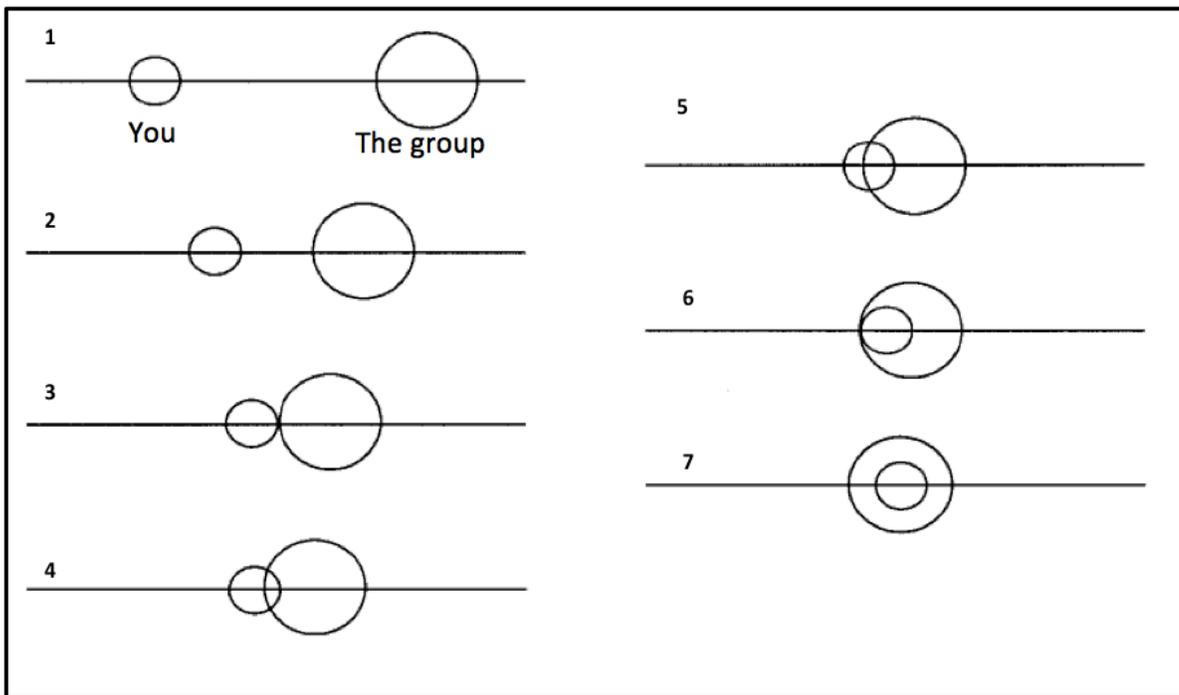

To help you understand the circles above, note that:

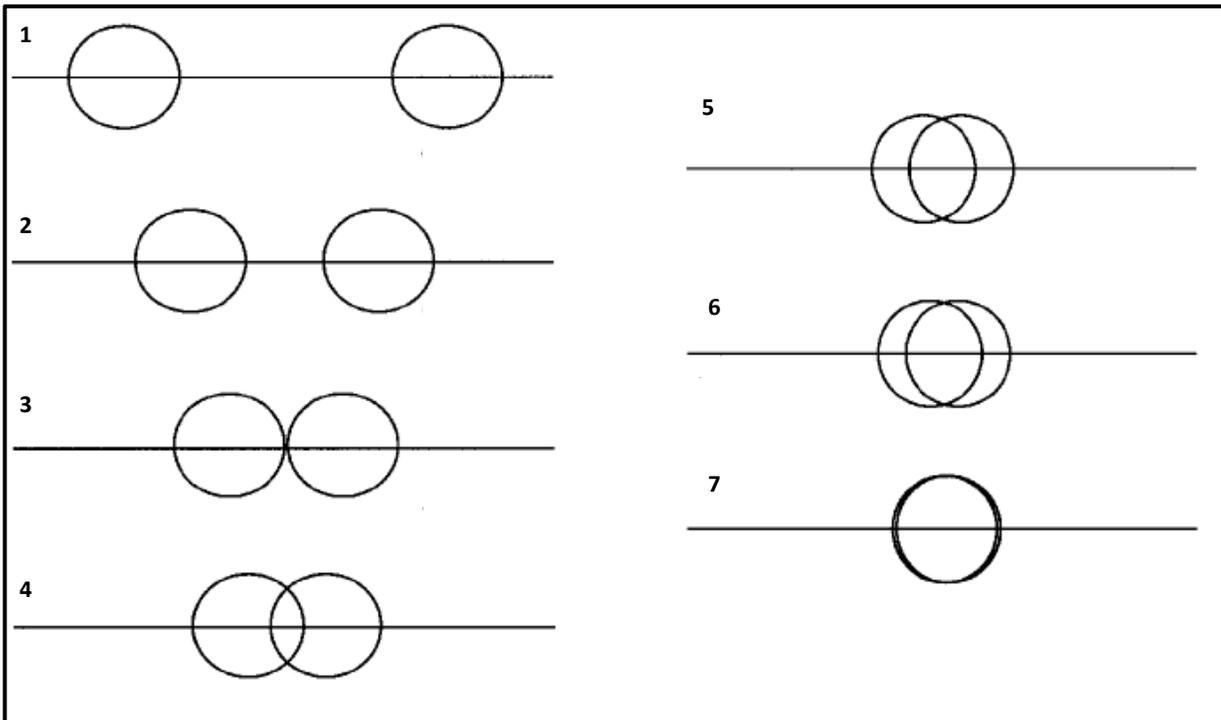
- 1 Indicates that you feel far from the group

- 6 Indicates that you feel a part of that group but on the fringe
- 7 Indicates that you feel wholly a part of that group.
